

## **LOUISIANA VISION PROGRAM NAMING OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Youth Education Endowment**

\$100,000

This fund will support free admission for public and private school children K-6.

### **Special Exhibitions Endowment**

\$250,000

Each semester the museum presents at least one special exhibition on loan from another museum, traveling exhibition service or private collections. Income from this fund will support the costs associated with presenting special exhibitions to the community. Exhibitions will bear donor recognition on Gallery Entrance panels, education and publicity materials.

### **Assistantships and Fellowships for Graduate Students**

\$50,000

To provide funding for graduate students working in the area of museum studies, museum administration or art history.

### **Endowed Directorship**

\$100,000

To provide annual salary supplements and research funds for the Museum's Director. An individual, family or foundation name would be affiliated with the directors title (e.g. *The Mary Alice Smith Director*).

### **Endowed Curator (Curator of Exhibitions)**

\$60,000

To provide annual salary supplements and research funds for the professional positions, Chief Curator, Curator of Decorative Arts, and Curator of the Louisiana Collections. Endowed Curatorships help ensure that the University can attract and retain distinguished and effective museum professionals. Annual stipends are awarded to Curators who are awarded such Curatorships. The Curator who receives such distinction carries the name of the donor. A named endowed curator at University Art Museum of UL Lafayette can be established with a gift of \$60,000 which is augmented with a \$40,000 match from the State of Louisiana's Board of Regents Support Fund (BORSF). Donors of endowed Curatorships receive annual reports from the UL Lafayette Foundation on the financial status of their endowment fund.

### **Endowed Museum Educator**

\$60,000

(Sometimes referred to as Curator of Education)

This professional is charged with the planning and execution of all educational and interpretive programming including youth school tours, outreach programs and adult education programs.
